

HITTING/PITCHING CLINIC INFORMATION

The East Central Community College Baseball Program again is offering a hitting and pitching clinic during Winter 2020 for players ages 6-12. The Hitting Clinic will be held on Monday evenings, with the exception of February 12, which is a Tuesday, from 6:15 to 8:15 p.m. The Pitching Clinic will be held from 6 to 7:15 p.m. each Thursday. The cost will be \$100 for the Hitting Clinic and \$75 for the Pitching Clinic. Participants can attend both clinics for \$150. The deadline to sign up is Thursday, January 17. Both camps were very successful last year and there are only a limited number of spaces available so early registration is encouraged.

This clinic is being offered to assist players in preparations for the spring. Instruction will be provided by East Central coaches and players.

Pitching Sessions will be divided between the Founders Gymnasium and the South Campus Gymnasium. Hitting Sessions will be held in the Indoor Practice Facility located in Founders' Gym. The indoor facility includes two full-length cages, an area for bunting, a pitching machine and several hitting stations.

Players will be divided into groups and will participate in drills including Batting Practice, Tee Drills, Soft Toss, Wiffle Balls, Bunting Techniques and other hitting-related exercises. Pitchers will learn the fundamental steps of a delivery as well as throw a supervised pen each week. They will also be instructed in other aspects such as arm care, pick moves and grips.
