Applicants wishing to be considered for the Cosmetology program **MUST** have the following items on file in the Office of Career & Technical Education by the application deadline:

ECCC Cosmetology Application Packet must include the following and on file in the Career-Technical Education Office by June 14, 2023.

- Application
- Questionnaire
- Essay
- An official high school transcript/high school equivalency transcript (ex: GED or HSE) MUST be on file with your cosmetology application.
- ACT score of 14 or better
- College GPA if applicable does not have to be an official transcript

NOTE:

- Acceptance to the College does not guarantee acceptance into the Cosmetology program.
- High school/high school equivalency transcripts (GED or HSE) on file in the Office of Admissions will not be considered as part of a completed

application packet. The official transcript MUST be on file in the Career & Technical Education Office <u>WITH</u> your cosmetology application.

- Official high school equivalency transcript (GED or HSE)/official high school transcripts must be on file in the Career & Technical Education Office.
 Only official transcripts from accredited high schools will be accepted per State Board for Cosmetology.
- An official high school equivalency transcript (GED or HSE) or official high school transcript MUST be signed with an official seal.
- Official transcripts **CAN NOT** be emailed or faxed.

Students are selected by the Cosmetology Interview Committee based on the following criteria:

- Completed Cosmetology Application Packet
- Highschool GPA/GED Rank
- College GPA if applicable does not have to be an official transcript
- ACT Score
- High School Attendance
- Attendance at 1 of the Cosmetology Preview Days
- Body Language/Overall Interview

Only those applicants that have been accepted/provisionally accepted with the East Central Community College Admissions Department and with a <u>completed cosmetology application packet</u> (application, questionnaire, essay, ACT score, and official high school transcript/official high school equivalency (GED or HSE) transcript) will be reviewed and assessed according to academic merit.

Interviews will be conducted with those students meeting **ALL** entrance requirements (completed Cosmetology application file and acceptance to ECCC with a completed application file in the Office of Admissions). The top 20 students will be chosen for the Cosmetology class. You will be notified by mail of your interview date and time after the deadline of **June 14, 2024**

Career & Technical Education Substance Abuse Testing Policy

To ensure a drug-free workplace and learning environment, East Central Community College students enrolled in specific Career & Technical Education programs that are skills-based and/or require the use of heavy equipment are required to submit to initial, random, and reasonable suspicion substance abuse testing. To review the entire <u>Policy No: 411.7 Career-Technical Substance Abuse Testing Policy</u>, refer to the college's online Policies and Procedures Manual located at www.eccc.edu.



ACT Residual Test Information:

- You must make your own appointment to take this exam. No one can make the appointment on your behalf.
- You must have applied to ECCC and received an ECCC student ID number to take this exam.
- Anyone wishing to test must present a valid photo ID such as a driver's license, military ID, student ID, etc. **No one will be allowed to test without proper identification**. Identification will be rechecked after the assessment is completed.
- No cell phones, pagers, timers, drinks, food, or tobacco products are allowed in the testing area.
- An approved ACT calculator may be used. (*Cell phone and TI-89 or TI-92 graphing calculators are NOT allowed.*)
- The ACT Residual Test is a timed test that takes approximately 4 hours to complete.
- All sections of the ACT Residual Test must be completed in order to receive a score.
- Students who arrive after their scheduled testing time will not be allowed to take the test.
- Residual ACT scores are not transferable to other colleges.
- ECCC will not send scores to individuals, businesses, or other educational entities.
- To qualify for dual credit or to skip Intermediate courses, students may take the Accuplacer twice or take the Accuplacer once and the ACT Residual Test once.
- Students may take the ACT Residual Test multiple times for program admission.
- If you have taken the ACT Residual Test within the last 60 days, you cannot test again until 60 days have passed.
- The cost for the ACT Residual Test is \$69. Students will be given a receipt upon payment at the Business Office. **This receipt must be presented upon arrival for testing.**
- Testing fees may be paid in the ECCC Business Office located in the Arno Vincent Administration Building.
- The accepted forms of payment are cash, check, VISA, or MasterCard.
- If you would like to request special accommodations, you must have previously registered for the ACT National Test and been approved for special testing accommodations. You may use your approved ACT National Extended Time/Special Testing Letter to request special accommodations for the ACT Residual Test.
- Childcare is not provided. Children are not allowed to remain unattended in the library or elsewhere on ECCC property.
