 - Achieved a score of Silver on the ACT WorkKeys or achieved a 16 on the ACT;
 - Have a DOT physical;
 - Have a Class A CDL permit with Air Brake enhancement;
 - Complete the East Central Community College Electrical Utility Lineman packet.
