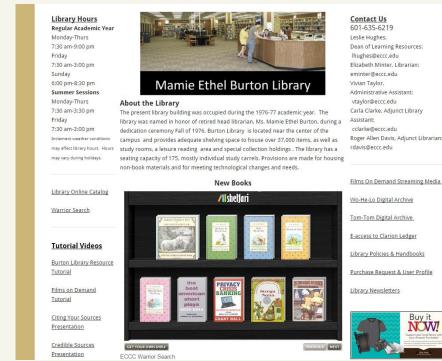

The <u>Citing Your</u> <u>Sources Presentation</u> and <u>Credible Sources Presentation</u> are both done through Prezi software. The <u>A to Z the World Overview</u>, <u>CQ Researcher Overview</u>, <u>CREDO</u> <u>Reference Overview</u>, <u>Opposing Viewpoints Overview</u>, and <u>World Book Online Overview</u> were done with screen recording and music, but no vocal narration.
