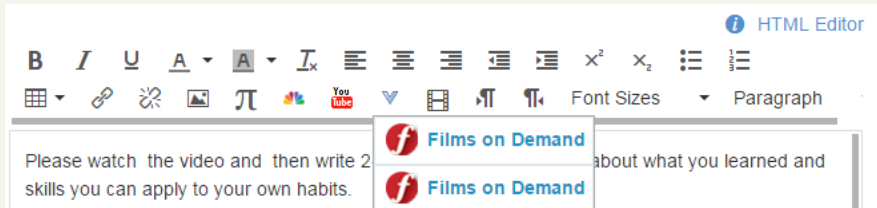
We have also added a “Buy It Now” icon with a link on the bottom-right side of our webpage.

ADDITIONS TO FILMS ON DEMAND STREAMING MEDIA

While we’ve had access to Films On Demand Streaming Media for two years, we only had access to the Humanities & Social Sciences Collection (14,517 videos) and Nursing Video Collection (515 videos). Starting in September, we will now have access to the Master Academic Package (which includes the Humanities & Social Sciences Collection, with many others for a total of 23,267 videos) and the Master Career & Technical Education Package (3,246 videos), as well as the Nursing Video Collection. They can be accessed from the Library webpage through the gold search box under the “Find More” tab, or under the “Subject Guides” link on the Library or Success Center webpage under the “General Research” tab. They can also be searched for and integrated into your Canvas content as shown below. The Master Academic Package provides every academic department on campus with the most essential video titles for their field of study that have been carefully curated for that purpose. It features titles from trusted producers such as A&E, PBS, BBC, National Geographic, ABC News, NBC News, CNBC, Canadian Broadcasting Corporation, MacNeil/Lehrer Productions, Open University, Bill Moyers, California Newsreel, TED, Films for the Humanities & Sciences, and more. It includes the Health & Medicine Collection, Humanities & Social Sciences Collection, Science & Mathematics Collection, Business & Economics Collection, and Archival Films & Newsreels Collection.

The Master Career & Technical Education Package is an essential resource for any university’s career center or counseling department, and a powerful educational tool for colleges offering associate degrees. Featuring exclusive producers such as Shopware, Cambridge Educational, and Meridian Education, this collection also meets Perkins guidelines. It includes the Career & Job Search Collection, Technical Education Collection, Guidance & Counseling Collection, and Family & Consumer Science Collection.

The Nursing Video Collection is designed not only to help nursing students excel in their studies and pass licensure exams, but also to prepare them for long-term success in an increasingly complex health care system. It features titles from trusted producers

such as Cengage Learning/Concept Media, NEVCO, Wolters Kluwer Health, Institutes for Professional Care Education/Medifecta, and others.
