

Surgical Technology Certificate (and) Associate of Applied Science Degree

Surgical Technology is an instructional program that prepares an individual to serve as a member of the surgical healthcare team.

Certificate:

Graduates of the 12-month program will be awarded the Certificate of Surgical Technology. Qualified graduates may apply to the Association of Surgical Technologists for the National Certifying Examination and become a Certified Surgical Technologist.

Associate of Applied Science Degree:

The Associate of Applied Science Degree in Surgical Technology will be awarded to the successful graduate of the 24-month program.

Admission Requirements:

 The student must apply for regular admission or readmission and be accepted by the college.
Applicants must submit a completed application for the Surgical Technology program

to the Office of Healthcare Education. 3) Must be eighteen (18) years of age or older.

4) Must have a high school diploma or GED.

5) Must be in good physical condition as verified by a medical examination and certifying report (National Certification Requirement).

5) Must have a an ACT composite score of 16 with a 12 in math and reading, or 12 composite if taken before October 1989, with a 12 in math and reading.

6) Applicants must undergo a personal interview with the admissions committee.

7) Applicants must be recommended by the Surgical Technology Admissions Committee.

8) Applicants must refer to college catalog for post acceptance requirements.

9) Candidates must have <u>no</u> visible tattoos on hands or face.

Scholarships and Financial Aid:
